

SOFTWARE USER LICENCE AGREEMENT

This User Licence Agreement is legally binding between the International Council of Marine Industry Associations (“ICOMIA”) and you, the “User”, either acting on your own account or on behalf of your employer.

It is hereby agreed that the User will be licensed to use ICOMIA's compiled Microsoft Excel 2007 (or later version) spreadsheet in support of ISO 12215-5:2008(E) (the “Software”) free of charge for the sole purpose of their own use in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Licence Agreement.

If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this Licence Agreement you must not install or use the Software.

Purchase of ISO12215-5:2008 (hard copy) standard.

The Software is a calculation tool the use of which is ancillary to ISO12215-5:2008 and not a substitute for the Standard. The Software is made available only to those persons who have purchased one or more hard copies of ISO-12215-5:2008 from ISO or from a reseller authorised by ISO. The use of the Software by any person who does not own an authorised copy of the standard is strictly forbidden.

Copyright

Copyright in the Software belongs to ICOMIA. The User may make one copy of the Software for each project that the User is engaged in on condition that the project files reside at all times on the User’s own computer and nowhere else and that the files bear the name of the project to which they relate. Distribution of the Software to third parties is not permitted. The output of the Software may be distributed to third parties in the form of a document file or hard copy only.

Performance of the Software

The User must make reference to the official ISO standard 12215-5:2008 when using the Software application. It is ABSOLUTELY ESSENTIAL that the User should read and understand the inherent limitations of ISO-12215-5:2008 as set out in the 'Introduction' and 'Scope' sections of the standard.

The Software is provided “as is” without warranty of any kind. While reasonable efforts have been made to validate the Software against the standard responsibility for checking the Software and its output against the standard prior to any practical application rests solely with the User.

ICOMIA will use reasonable endeavours to resolve any reported problems found in running the Software, but ICOMIA does not guarantee to fix any problems in the Software or to provide any updates or patches by a particular date or at all.

ICOMIA further disclaims all implied warranties including, without limitation, any implied warranties of merchantability or of fitness for a particular purpose. The entire risk arising out of the use or performance of the Software and documentation remains with the User.

Other Restrictions

The User will not rent, lease, sublicense, transfer, resell the software application (either in whole or in part) or use it for commercial purposes without ICOMIA's prior written permission. Nor will the User attempt to decompile, amend or bundle the Software.

No Liability for Damages

To the fullest extent permitted by law neither ICOMIA nor anyone else who has been involved in the creation, production, or delivery of the Software shall be liable for any direct or indirect, consequential, or incidental, penal or exemplary damages (including, without limitation, damages for loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information or other pecuniary loss) arising out of the use or inability to use the Software, even if ICOMIA has been advised of the possibility of such damages or claims. The User bears all risk as to the quality and performance of the Software.

Law and Jurisdiction

This Licence Agreement and any non-contractual obligations arising out of, or in connection with, this Licence Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, English law. The Courts of England and Wales shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction for the hearing and determination of any claims arising under this Licence Agreement whether contractual or non-contractual and the User hereby consents to such jurisdiction. The User further irrevocably consents to any process in any legal action being served on it by electronic means. Nothing contained in this agreement shall affect the right to serve process in any other manner permitted by law.
